I remember my Grandparents used its leaves in our Food because; sometimes we had no meat or fish and not even mushroom from the fields to eat. We had a vegan lifestyle without even knowing it.

The oil of the Moringa is used for cooking and the after showering it is also used as a body and hair cream. It is also used on minor cuts, scorpion stings, diabetic's sores, boils, eczema, snakebites and all other kind of skin problems.

My Grandmother also prepared it for pregnant women in those days. The tea was used during pregnancy to bring nutrients to the unborn baby and afterwards to help produce breast milk to feed the little one.

Everywhere I go I take Moringa leaves and seeds with me to strengthen my immune system.

I shared my story of this Miracle whole food tree with my partner and we decided to share its remedies with others. I am living in Austria and started classes to learn the German language. During this time I shared my story with my teacher and gave her some tea to try. After some weeks she asked me why I am not selling this amazing product, as her Father who is 90 years old truly loves it because he regain his health and vitality back.

The natural Moringa we sell and distribute is of the highest quality, organically grown and harvested in Ghana. We are using a system known as Permaculture. It means that the Moringa is grown using no unnatural interventions or pesticides.

The Moringa Tree is a healer of itself and needs no fertilizer but can be used as a fertilizer for other trees and crops. There are many names given to this wonder tree, in Ayurvedic Medicine it is called the Drumstick Tree and can be used in the treatment of 300 diseases. In Africa its called Mothers best friend and tree of life as it has saved many from starvation.

Our goal is to Support African Women with low incomes or those who are unable to generate their own revenue, to take care of their families and also help the homeless children and orphans. We would like to invest in their education by building a library and also have a mobile library to get to those areas that would otherwise not have access to books.
